SPEECH AND OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY SERVICES STILL AVAILABLE AT IMMACULATE CONCEPTION

At Immaculate Conception School of Special Education, we are dedicated to supporting all our students' academic and developmental needs. As part of our ongoing commitment to providing the highest quality education and care, we are pleased to continue to offer speech and occupational therapies each Monday in partnership with Wellstar Health /Augusta University. These services enhance students' communication, motor skills, and overall functional abilities, helping them thrive in the classroom and beyond.

How to Sign Up for Speech and Occupational Therapy Services
Parents interested in enrolling their child in speech and/or occupational therapy must follow a simple process:

- 1. Request a Packet from Ms. Daphne: Parents should contact Ms. Daphne at the front desk to request the necessary paperwork. She will provide you with all the forms you need to get started.
- 2. Complete and Submit the Paperwork: After receiving the packet, the parent or guardian must complete the paperwork and submit it directly to Wellstar Health. All of the necessary instructions for submitting the documents will be provided in the packet.
- 3. Insurance and Invoicing: Once Wellstar reviews and approves the paperwork, they will invoice the family directly for the therapy services. The Wellstar team will also handle all insurance filings, making the process seamless for you.

LASTLY, WE ARE PARTNERING WTIH AUGUSTA UNIVERSITY TO ALLOW THEIR SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY MASTER LEVEL STUDENTS TO DO THEIR STUDENT TEACHING AT IC. WE MAY ALSO BE PARTNERING WTH THE BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB TO PROVIDE AN AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAM AND SUMMER PROGRAM. STAY TUNED AS WE CONTINUE TO GROW AND EXPAND WHAT WE CAN OFFER.



RICHMOND COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SPEECH SERVICES FOR PRIVATE SCHOOL STUDENTS

IN ADDITION TO THE THERAPY SERVICES PROVIDED BY WELLSTAR, THERE IS AN IMPORTANT OPTION FOR PARENTS WHO WOULD LIKE THEIR CHILD TO RECEIVE FREE SPEECH THERAPY THROUGH THE RICHMOND COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM.

IF YOUR CHILD PREVIOUSLY HAD SPEECH SERVICES OUTLINED IN THEIR IEP (INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PLAN) BEFORE ENROLLING AT IMMACULATE CONCEPTION, YOU CAN REQUEST CONTINUED SPEECH SERVICES THROUGH RICHMOND COUNTY. HERE'S HOW:

- 1. <u>CONTACT RICHMOND COUNTY SPECIAL EDUCATION:</u> PARENTS NEED TO CONTACT THE DEPARTMENT OF SPECIAL EDUCATION AT RICHMOND COUNTY AND REQUEST THAT THEIR CHILD RECEIVE SPEECH SERVICES WHILE ATTENDING IMMACULATE CONCEPTION SCHOOL OF SPECIAL EDUCATION.
- 2. <u>SPEECH SERVICES PROVIDED BY RICHMOND COUNTY:</u> ONCE THE REQUEST IS PROCESSED, RICHMOND COUNTY MAY PROVIDE SPEECH THERAPY IN ONE OF TWO WAYS:
- A. AN SLP (SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST) MAY COME TO THE SCHOOL TWICE A WEEK TO PROVIDE SERVICES.
 B. ALTERNATIVELY, RICHMOND COUNTY MAY OFFER ONLINE THERAPY SESSIONS TWICE A WEEK FOR ELIGIBLE STUDENTS.
- IT'S IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT SPEECH SERVICES ARE THE ONLY SERVICES RICHMOND COUNTY MUST PROVIDE TO PRIVATE SCHOOL STUDENTS. THESE SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE AT NO COST TO FAMILIES, MAKING IT A GREAT OPTION FOR THOSE WHO QUALIFY.

WHY SPEECH AND OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY MATTER

BOTH SPEECH AND OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIES PLAY A CRUCIAL ROLE IN A CHILD'S DEVELOPMENT, PARTICULARLY FOR STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS. THESE THERAPIES IMPROVE CRITICAL SKILLS, ENHANCING COMMUNICATION, MOTOR FUNCTIONS, AND OVERALL INDEPENDENCE. BY OFFERING THESE THERAPIES ON-SITE AT IMMACULATE CONCEPTION, STUDENTS CAN RECEIVE THE SUPPORT THEY NEED WITHOUT MISSING OUT ON THEIR ACADEMIC SCHEDULES.

THE IMPORTANCE OF A ROBUST STEM PROGRAM

FOR STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

STEM EDUCATION IS MORE IMPORTANT THAN EVER, BUT FOR STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS, PURSUING CAREERS IN THESE FIELDS CAN SEEM DAUNTING. AT IMMACULATE CONCEPTION SCHOOL OF SPECIAL EDUCATION, OUR ROBUST STEM PROGRAM IS DESIGNED TO EMPOWER STUDENTS, OFFERING NOT JUST ACADEMIC OPPORTUNITIES BUT ALSO PERSONAL GROWTH, REAL-WORLD SKILLS, AND CAREER PATHWAYS.

1. <u>DEVELOPING PROBLEM-SOLVING AND CRITICAL THINKING</u>

STEM EDUCATION ENCOURAGES STUDENTS TO ENGAGE IN HANDS-ON, PROJECT-BASED LEARNING, FOSTERING SKILLS LIKE PROBLEM-SOLVING, CREATIVITY, AND PERSEVERANCE. THESE ARE ESSENTIAL FOR SUCCESS BOTH INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE CLASSROOM, BUILDING CONFIDENCE AND RESILIENCE.
